### **Executive Committee Reports**

Washington High School was one of four schools to receive #1 ratings in six categories. Dr. Plagman stated," in music we are the state champions, thanks to the talent of the students and our great directors".

PPA has \$4,858.83 earmarked for the fund, leaving a balance of \$2,724.22. Lisa Thirnbeck moved that PPA commit the \$2,724.22 balance. Second/Passed

Molly Williams moved PPA disperse \$80,000.00 to Washington High school for the 2009/2010 school year expenses per Dr. Plagman's written request (attached). Second/Passed
