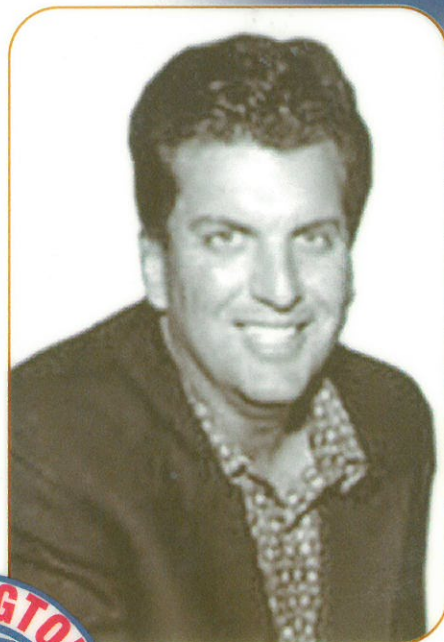


# Tim Daugherty



Inducted into the *Hall of Fame* in 1995

Tim is a 1976 graduate of Washington. Tim was also encouraged by Washington Band Director Richard Brickley to write a special arrangement for the jazz band celebrating the nation's bicentennial in 1976. Composition and writing were a pleasure that Tim enjoyed so much that he even wrote for his junior high jazz band. He composed music for many of the rock groups that he was involved with throughout his teen years. One of his compositions was awarded with a national award from the Songwriters of America for best jazz composition by a high school senior.

Tim pursued a liberal arts education at the University of Iowa where his interests were with computers at about the time when music and computers became intertwined. He was in the performing group, Johnson County Landmark, the top rated jazz collegiate ensemble which performed in Amsterdam during his senior year in college. It was that year that Tim realized he wanted to pursue a career in music.



In 1983 the Daugherty, Davis, and McPartland trio was formed and has been a mainstay of jazz in this area ever since.

Mr. Daugherty has given his talent to youth through the Reach Out Program for children in the Cedar Rapids school system and then as a fulltime artist in the Iowa Touring Arts Program. He wrote original music for the touring company of the Old Creamery Theatre and orchestral arrangements for the Cedar Rapids Follies productions. He has written award winning commercials and produced video which has been broadcast throughout Iowa.
