Inducted into the *Hall of Fame* in 2014

Bob and Bobbi Cline were PPA band representatives from 1986-1989 and again from 1991- 1995. They served as membership chairs in 1994-1995 and as president in 1994-1995. During their time on the board, they helped revamp the Five Seasons Marching Band Invitational in collaboration with a parent from Jefferson High School. During their tenure, the PPA reached new highs in membership and fundraising.

The Clines were chaperones on band trips to Chicago, Florida, The Bahamas, Washington DC, and New York City. They also became adept at moving pit equipment for the marching band as well as driving the Warrior Wagon and helping the directors as needed. They worked with the Athletic Booster Club to help raise funds for new band uniforms.

Both Bobbi and Bob are educators. Bobbi is a member of the Regional Center for EMS Education at Kirkwood Community College and Bob is a Lecturer of Marketing at the Tippie School of Management, The University of Iowa. Above all, their most important contribution to the arts community was raising two children who, along with their spouses, have become arts professionals in the local community, and their six grandchildren who are also very active in the performing arts.
