
Mare and Cathy Gullickson

As part of the original committee exploring whether or not to host a show choir competition, Dr. Gerald Kreitzer recalls committee member Marc Gullickson saying, "I think we should stage an event that has all the fun elements of every competition we've been at and avoids all the unpleasantness of some of the other events. Oh, by the way, I've got a great name that plays off the name Momentum and will identify us in a special way, one that reflects having Mo-fun, Mo-singing, Mo-Dance, and Mo-Show!" He also is credited with designing the "Stupid Student Tricks" portion of the show.

Without the enthusiasm, creativity, and determination of Marc and Cathy, and the other choir committee members, Mo-Show would not have become the event that it is. They have served as Host Committee chairs, and Cathy served as the Chairperson of Mo-Show in 1991. It is the largest fund-raising event for the PPA.

Marc and Cathy are parents of three children, all Washington High school graduates. Marc and Cathy became involved in PPA in the fall of 1992 and have been involved every year since. Their PPA offices have included Choir Representatives, Publicity, Secretary, and Vice President-Fund Raising, some of which they have served more than once.

Cathy was on the original committee that created the Fab Five Show Choir Extravaganza and served for two years as Washington's representative. She also was the WHS representative on the committee that organized and produced *150-year Leap*, *Iowa's Musical Heritage*, an official Sesquicentennial event held February 29, 1996.
