

# Norvin and Alice Hoffmeier

Norvin and Alice were married in 1963 after Alice arrived in Cedar Rapids to teach at Johnson Elementary. After their children were born, Alice became a "stay-at-home mom" and Norvin continued his profession as a certified public accountant.

The Hoffmeiers were consistent supporters of the performing arts at Washington High School and throughout the community. They have been involved with Patrons of the Performing Arts since 1985 and served as President during the 1988-89 school year. Alice was also named to the Warrior Athletic Club Hall of Fame in 1994.

Music, sports, and travel played significant roles in the lives of Norvin and Alice Hoffmeier. Alice has been a member of the Cedar Rapids Symphony Guild (President 1995-97), the Beethoven Club since 1967 (President 1977-78), and a member of the Board of Directors for the Cedar Rapids Opera Theatre. Norvin served on the Artistic Committee of the Cedar Rapids Symphony and was a member of National Association of Railroad Passengers and the Iowa Association of Railroad Passengers. In 1996, Alice was honored as an Olympic torch bearer as the torch passed through Cedar Rapids on its way to Salt Lake City.
