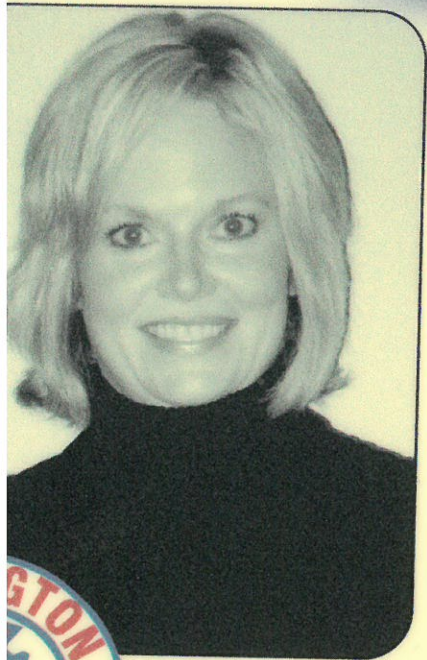


# Suzanne Kiliper Krejci

Inducted into the *Hall of Fame* in 2007



Suzanne Kiliper Krejci graduated from Washington High School in 1987, where she was principal oboe in the band and orchestra during her three high school years. A three year All-State musician, Suzanne served as principal oboe in the All-State orchestra her senior year. She received an Outstanding Musician Award at the World of Music Festival in Minneapolis in 1986 and an Outstanding Contest Performance Award at the State Solo and Ensemble Contest in 1987. She was the principal oboe in the University of Iowa Honor Band in 1987.

As a senior, Suzanne was the featured soloist with the Washington High School Band at the 60th Annual Iowa Bandmasters Association Concert and won Washington's prestigious Evelyn Daugherty Scholarship for music. Suzanne was also the featured soloist with the Cedar Rapids City Municipal Band immediately after high school graduation.

In addition, Suzanne was an all-around athlete who won eight varsity letters in three years, was an All-State volleyball player and won Washington's Orville Rust Award. In the year 2000, Suzanne was inducted into the Washington Warrior Athletic Hall of Fame.

After college, Suzanne taught for ten years at both Jefferson and Washington high schools and coached volleyball during her five years at Jefferson. Her varsity teams won three consecutive conference championships and earned two state tournament berths, placing 2nd in 1996.

Suzanne volunteers extensively and is an elementary PTA President. She developed Washington High School's profile for the Iowa Hall of Pride Center in Des Moines and wrote the script for Washington's 50th year celebration DVD.

Suzanne is married to Harding Principal, Randy Krejci, and they are the parents of nine year old Liz and five year old Hannah.
