

Spencer Pink

Inducted into the *Hall of Fame* in 1997

Spencer Pink graduated from the University of Northern Iowa in 1959 with degrees in Art and Speech. His entire career was devoted to students in the performing and fine arts.

Spencer began in the Cedar Rapids schools as a teacher and Drama Director at Wilson Junior High School from 1959 – 1966. After one year as the Technical Director at Jefferson High School, he accepted the position of teacher, designer, and Technical Director for the theatre programs at Washington. The marriage of his artistic gifts and his passion for performance created some of the most stunning stage designs Washington has ever seen.

In 1976, Mr. Pink shifted his focus to full-time art teacher, although he continued to provide expertise in technical theatre, serving as the Technical Director for the Cedar Rapids Educational Dance Theatre and the University of Alaska Fine Arts Camp in 1984.

After retiring from Washington in 1999, Spencer taught at Summit Schools until 2002.
