Terry Shaffer has been associated with Washington High School Performing Arts since joining the faculty in the 1970s. His three children participated in virtually every music group and on the stage in a variety of productions. For many years, Terry was the semi-official driver/chaperone of the Warrior Wagon, touring with the school groups traveling all over the country to competitions and special performances. Additionally, Terry has served as Assistant Technical Director and special props carpenter.

Terry has an extensive theatre background, appearing in many roles for Theatre Cedar Rapids and other organizations. Among his favorite productions were *Fiddler on the Roof*, *Jesus Christ Superstar*, *My Fair Lady*, *Funny Girl*, *The Music Man*, and *The Pirates of Penzance*.
