Bill Lammers spent 34 years working in educational theater and 31 of those years as a full-time educator. His career began here at Wash where he completed both his practicum and student teaching experiences during the 1987-88 school year.

While completing his certifications and degree at The University of Iowa, he was hired and worked as the Assistant Technical Director for the WHS Drama Department. After substitute teaching during the 1989-90 school year, Mr. Lammers was hired by Clinton High School in 1990 as a Language Arts teacher and the Director of Theater. Three years later, he was hired to replace Dave Smith as a Language Arts Teacher and Technical Director to the Performing Arts at Washington.

In 1998, he was selected as a Summer Fellow at the Northwestern University's School of Speech and Theater, and he has twice been selected for the Cedar Rapids Rotary's Service Above Self Award. He directed and supervised the technical needs of 73 plays, 40 musicals, 25 MoShows, and hundreds of Performing Arts concerts, All-School assemblies and events during his tenure at Washington High School.
